MEN – ACCEPTABLE MEN – UNACCEPTABLE

Golf hats or peak caps
Caps to be worn with peak forward



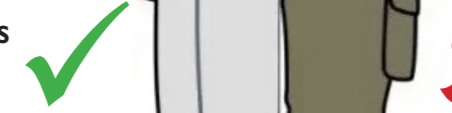
Caps with peaks facing the back

Collared or mock collared shirts with sleeves
Tucked into trousers at all time



T-shirts, vests, football style jerseys

Knee length tailored shorts or long trousers



Three-quarter length trousers, football style shorts
Denim wear, leisure suits, tracksuits

Long, ankle and trainer socks



Sandals or runners

Golf shoes with soft spikes



WOMEN – ACCEPTABLE WOMEN – UNACCEPTABLE

Golf hats or peak caps
Caps must be worn with peak forward



Caps with peaks facing the back

Collared shirts with or without sleeves



T-shirts, strappy tops, football style jerseys

Tailored shorts or long pants
Formal three-quarter length pants
Appropriate length golf skirt



Denim wear, jeans, tracksuits, football style shorts

Long, ankle or trainer socks



Sandals and runners

Golf shoes with soft spikes



IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Neat casual dress is essential in the clubhouse. Respectable denim is acceptable in the clubhouse provided it is not faded or torn. Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times in the clubhouse. Golf shoes may be worn on the veranda and in the locker rooms. Caps and hats should not be worn in the clubhouse (except in specific circumstances).
