



Subscriptions Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to set out the Club's Subscription's Policy.

2. Scope of Policy

This Policy applies to management committee, staff and members.

3. Policy

3.1 The Nenagh Golf Club members subscription will be determined each year at the Club AGM.

3.2 The Subscription payments will be overseen by the Club Subscription secretary, assisted by the office administrator.

3.3 The invoices for the different categories of invoices will be sent out to members by the first week in December unless in unusual circumstances at another date agreed by the Management Committee.

3.4 The categories agreed at the 2023 AGM are as follows:

Ordinary, Family, Country, Student, Junior cadet, Clubhouse, Honorary

The Management Committee recommended the following Category rates for membership applicable from January 1st 2026.

- Ordinary Members €800.00
- New Ordinary Members €800.00 Less 25% first year or part thereof. Membership must be lapsed for a period in excess of 5 years.
- Family €1350.00
- Spouse of Life Member- Difference between family and Ordinary Subscription.
- Youth Members 10-17 years of age €200.00
- Youth Member 10-17, additional Juniors in same family €150
- Students 18-24 years of age €250.00
- Country Members €500.00
- Clubhouse Members €100.00
- Cadet Members (under 10 years of age) € 50.00

3.5 A Social contribution of €40 is applicable to life and ordinary members/family €80.00 (€40 x 2)

3.6 Any member who pays his subscription in full by 31st January each year shall be entitled to a voucher for four green fees.

3.7 All membership fees must be paid on or before 28th February each year, unless the member has entered into a direct debit agreement with the subscriptions Secretary. All members using this facility will be monitored each month to ensure payments are up to date. If a payment defaults the individual is contacted immediately and all payments updated within two weeks of contact. If Payment is not updated see below.

3.8 Where a members subscription remains unpaid on the 28th of February (or whose Direct Debit has defaulted), the membership shall be deemed to have lapsed and the name of such member shall be removed from the Register of Members, Administration System, Golf Ireland System and Timesheet System, except in exceptional circumstances where the Committee of Management, at its absolute discretion, decide to extend the period of payment. They shall no longer have access to, or use, any of the Club's facilities and shall not be eligible for selection to represent the Club on any team or play in any open competitions as members of Nenagh Golf Club. The Subscriptions Secretary shall inform the Men's and Women's secretaries of the name of any such member. The Management Committee may re-elect members on payment of all subscriptions, arrears, and other penalties decided upon from time to time.

3.9 Cash is NOT acceptable as payment for membership fee.

3.10 In the event of an application for membership being rejected, the applicant will immediately be contacted. No further membership application from that applicant will be accepted until the following season.

3.11 A member may request to defer membership for one calendar year due to personal circumstances. During the deferral period, playing rights on the course and in practice areas are removed.

3.12 A member who has paid his/her subscription in full and is subsequently unable to play golf through illness can avail of the following concession.

A 5% per month credit (no refund) in the subscription fee paid will be applied in the following year up to a maximum 50% of the subscription fee paid. A medical certificate must be provided to the Finance & Subscriptions Committee on application request.

This concession only applies to members who will not be resuming for the rest of the membership year.

Partial ability to play is not considered as grounds for reduction of membership fees.

It is the sole decision of the Finance & Subscriptions Committee if a reduction is warranted.

3.13 Any Member falling under the following categories: Clubhouse, Cadet, Student, Country, Ordinary or Family Membership who wishes to change membership category for either the current year or the next calendar year will have to apply through the process outlined under Section 6 of the Constitution: Application for Membership. Applicants for Country membership must provide proof of address (utility bill issued within the last six months) and proof of Ordinary membership of another affiliated club at the application stage and at the start of each subsequent year, if membership is approved by the management committee.
