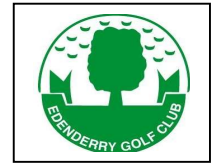




Duggan Cup - Competition Rules



1. This competition is confined to Senior Golfers, and each team shall consist of 10 male members and play shall be by foursome's match play.
2. Golfers must be aged 50 or over on 1st January.
3. The maximum Handicap Index for any player shall be 17.5 and the combined Handicap Index of any pair shall not be lower than 19.5 or higher than 32.0. [See example on Team Sheet]
4. The handicap allowance shall be half the difference of the combined Course Handicap of a Pair. [See example on Team Sheet]
5. The handicaps applicable shall be deemed to be the handicap held by the players on 1st January.
6. Players may use a buggy during the competition.
7. The club getting home advantage will be determined on a round-by-round basis (up to and including the quarter finals) as per Golf Ireland's rules for inter club competition. The draw sheet on the Edenderry Club website will be updated within 48 hours of the completion date of the previous round.
8. The club with the home draw [in Shaded Area] shall have 3 matches at home, except for the semi-finals and final which shall be played in Edenderry Golf.
9. All matches should be played to the finish.
10. All matches must be played by the date specified. No extensions will be granted, and both teams will be scratched unless a walkover is given.
11. **Winners must notify Edenderry Golf Club of results within 1 day of completion of the match.**
12. Entry Fee is €100.
13. The winning team will receive Perpetual Trophy, Pendant and Replicas.
14. Edenderry Golf Club will provide 15 meals to each team on Final day.

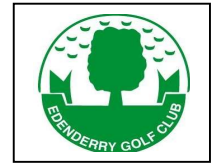
Where the same team wins the Cup in 2 successive years the team must change at least 4 members who played in the final on the 2nd year.

Practice rounds should be available for away players. Hosting clubs are expected to notify opponents of the Tees, Slope Par & Course Rating to be used for matches before practice rounds.
